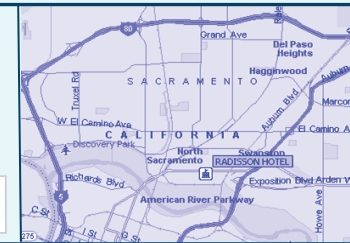

Lime in Soil Stabilization by Dallas N. Little

Dallas N. Little, Ph. D., P.E., is one of the most recognized experts in the field of asphalt binders and modifiers. He is currently the holder of the E.B. Snead endowed chair in Transportation Engineering in the Civil Engineering Department of Texas A&M University. He is a Senior Research Fellow at the Texas Transportation Institute and the Associate Director of the International Center for Aggregates Research. Professor Little has concentrated on research to improve asphalt, aggregate mixture design and analysis procedures.
